Pistol Skills Course - Malfunctions

Pistol Malfunctions Skills Course Information

This course will cover the three most common malfunctions on a semi-automatic pistol the shooter may encounter. Emphasis is on practical exercises, both through dry-fire and through live-fire exercises.

Course Prerequisite

The student should have had completed basic pistol safety course, such as the [NRA Basics of Pistol Shooting](#), [R. Soule's Basic Pistol Shooting 101](#) or equivalent.

Equipment Required

1 – Semi-automatic pistol

3 – Pistol magazines which fit the pistol

1 – Magazine pouch

1 – Pistol holster

50 rounds of ammunition for the pistol.

Eye and ear protection.

Course Objectives

At the end of this course of instruction, the student will be able to:

- Name the three types of pistol malfunctions most commonly experienced
- Will be able to identify the type of malfunction that has occurred
- Will be able to remediate the malfunction to get the pistol operational
- Explain and perform the Tap, Rack and Assess drill
